As most of you know, Bishop Barker has targeted in-person worship to possibly begin in July. We will worship as a 'scattered' Church through at least the month of June and possibly longer. We, of course, continue to hold Morning Prayer via Facebook Live at our usual worship time of 10:30 AM Sunday mornings. Hopefully, though, sooner, rather than later, we will once again fill the sanctuary with worship and praise to God.

But when we gather again for worship, some things will look a lot different. Bishop has made it clear that masks will be required as we enter and exit the church. Households will be expected to maintain the 6 feet social distancing and more than likely singing will be limited. Communion will also not involve the common cup. Governor Ricketts and Bishop Barker have been very clear about that. For Episcopalians this is difficult. The cup not only points us to our unity in Christ but also to what God is doing and has done for those who call upon God's name during the mass. We more than likely will still offer both the bread and wine, (although communion in one kind is acceptable, if you so wish) however you will not be able to drink from the communion chalice, nor dip the bread into the chalice for health reasons.

Yes, some churches have resumed in-person worship in our area, Governor Ricketts has allowed that to happen, but Bishop Barker is following the CDC recommendations of waiting till infections decrease in our county for 2 weeks before he will allow us to resume in-person worship; which has not happened yet.

When the time does come for us to resume in-person worship, you can be assured that we will follow all the best practices as recommended by health experts, but we will also continue to Livestream our worship for those who will not feel comfortable returning to worship right away or perhaps should not return to worship right away because of being in one of those high risk categories.

Right now we place Pastor Sheryl's iPhone on a tripod in front of the altar, something that will be very distracting to those gathered. Thankfully Bishop Barker, through the Clarkson Foundation is offering grants to encourage congregations to continue Livestreaming worship for the foreseeable future. To do this we will have to replace the sound system as well as add video equipment and a computer in the back of the sanctuary to make this all happen. This will provide a discrete way to connect those who will continue to worship at home with those of us who gather in the sanctuary.

One thing we must all keep clear in our mind is this: The pandemic is not over. It may seem like a Nebraska winter weather warning. We get a dusting while Chadron reels under 12 15 inches. The only way to keep things in the 'dusting' phase is to stay vigilant, wash our hands, and eliminate touchpoints. We haven't got a consistent approach to treatment nor a vaccine, therefore we need to stay cautious and prepared, and keep concern just for ourselves but for all of God's children.

In the meantime may the God of Peace keep you in the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ.
