Countries around the world are still reporting a large number of cases, India is out of hospital beds and there is some concern over the latest mutations. We will all probably need a booster this fall and locally the vaccination rate is frankly, poor. So, no we still have a ways to go yet.

Many of you are tired of hearing about Covid and are more than ready to ditch the masks and restrictions all together. As a Church, we are taking a 'go slow' approach, we have members who cannot be vaccinated and those who for various reasons have chosen not to. 
