FROM THE DESKS OF PASTORS SHERYL AND CHRIS KESTER-BEYER

Dear Friends,

Are you running on empty? As many of you know, Pastor Chris and I spend a lot of time during the summer bicycling (in fact, we have planned a bicycling vacation this summer to Northern Wisconsin which will average approximately 50 miles per day). One of the things you quickly discover when you do those kinds of miles on a bicycle is that fueling is very important, just as it is for a car or motorcycle. In bicycle lingo, when you run out of fuel, it's known as 'bonking' and the tell-tale signs are loss of energy and increased irritability (at least in me!). But despite the fact that I know better, there have been times on previous bike trips when I didn't eat properly and found myself running low on fuel; running on empty.

When you're bicycling it's a pretty easy thing to refuel—at least as long as you're smart enough to carry food with you on the bike or take advantage of the convenience store or restaurants strategically placed about every 5 to 10 miles along the way.

But what kind of surprises me, is how quickly I can 'bonk' spiritually. Life gets busy, meetings run late, I don't sleep well a few nights in a row and soon I'm talking myself out of getting up early to spend time with God, and before I know it, I'm running on empty.

To be honest, this happened to me just this past Lent and that's when God helped me see that I had been forgetting to take the time to refuel spiritually. Just as my body needs to be recharged through regular and frequent meals to be able to function at its best, so too my soul needs regular infusions of God's grace and power for my spiritual life to function at its best. And even though I knew better, I had been neglecting to stop at God's refuel station and fill up. As a result, I was running on empty.

So, what about you? Are you running on empty? Have you been neglecting to stop at God's refuel station and fill up? Are you taking the time to get regular infusions of God's grace and power in your life? Do you even know how? In reality, just as in bicycling, it's a pretty easy thing to refuel—we simply need to learn to take advantage of the gifts God has given to us for that purpose—gifts like prayer and meditation, worship and devotions, or small group study.

So are you running on empty? Then schedule time into your day and week to be with God. Use a devotion to guide your prayer time. Make weekly worship attendance a priority, even during the summer. And feel free to stop in and talk with Pastor Chris or me about your spiritual journey if you feel like you need some direction and guidance in that area. After all, helping you to connect to God and grow in your faith is what we are here for.
