FROM THE DESKS OF PASTORS SHERYLAND CHRISKESTER-BEYER

As I write this, another bombing has taken place in Manchester, England. That's not much different than, say Omaha. Manchester is a larger city in 'rural' England not really very far from Scotland. Margaret, I think would agree with this assessment. That gives this a feeling, "What about here?" " Are we 'safe'?" And the answer is... "Well..."

The point is we again find ourselves asking questions such as, "How long, O lord?" Questions raised by the saints in the book of Revelation. Questions about evil and God's plan for us and our world. Questions about who would do such a thing and why?

The questions have always been there, and sadly, I have written about them before. As we pray for the victims of the Manchester bombing let us remember the words of Psalm 23, "Though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, your rod and your staff comfort me." In other words, as I travel dark and foreboding paths, your presence, O Lord, gives me hope. Yes, God continues to walk with us and continually reminds us, "Don't be afraid."

To this I urge that you continue to pray with those saints in the book of Revelation, "How Long, O Lord?" We, as the people of God, await Jesus coming again, as the book of Revelation ends, to dry every tear. That is what Ascension Day is all about! Not that Christ has left us, but as he promised, "Lo, I am with you even to the end of the age." And as the men in white say to the disciples, "...this Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven will come in the same way..." Acts 8:11. So let us pray for Jesus' coming that evil may be destroyed once for all. This is our hope. And let us pray for God's kingdom to come among us, even now, praying for world leaders to respond with wisdom and not necessarily with more violence. And pray for those who we think of as enemies, as Christ has taught us.
